SBIF grants use local Tax Increment Financing (TIF) revenue to reimburse you for the pre-approved repair or rehab of your business facilities or adjacent land acquisition. SBIF grants are available for commercial and industrial businesses and property owners. No residential. SBIF provides grants up to \$150,000 to commercial businesses for 90% of the costs of permanent building improvements such as storefront renovations, building systems, interior remodeling, and roof replacement.
